Vincenzo Fogliano (Naples (I), 1965), graduated cum laude in Chemistry did the first 20 years of his career at the University of Naples “Federico II” being assistant and later associate professor in Biochemistry, Food Chemistry and Functional Foods. He is authors of more than 250 publications on indexed journals (h index 44) covering many aspects of Food science and he was recently included in the prestigious list of the “Highly Cited” scientists made by ISI <http://highlycited.com/>

In the design of new food products he collaborated with many leading food industries as well as with small companies and local producers.

Prof. Fogliano is presently the chair of Food Quality & Design group at the University of Wageningen (WUR) from September 2013. The chair comprises an international research team of about 70 people including an average of 40 PhDs. The focus of the research is on the design of innovative healthy foods adopting a chain perspective from the selection of raw materials, through processing and formulation up to the physiological functionality and consumer behavior. The chair developed a techno managerial approach to promote quality along food chain.
