

CURRICULUM VITAE

Dr. Maria Antonella Muraro

Prof. Maria Antonella Muraro is a paediatrician and an allergist and , since 2005, she has been the Head of the Referral Centre for Food Allergy of Veneto Region, at the Department of the Woman and Child Health , Padua University hospital in the North-Eastern part of Italy . Since 2013 she has been Professor of Food Allergy and Pediatric allergy at the University of Padua.

She is Past-President of the European Academy of Allergology and Clinical Immunology (EAACI) . She has previously held the positions of President (from 2015-2017)Secretary General (2013-2015), Treasurer (2009-2013) as well as Chair and Secretary of the Section on Paediatrics

Prof..Muraro was the initiator in 2013 of the EAACI project of Guidelines for Clinical practice . She chaired the EAACI Guidelines for Food Allergy and Anaphylaxis published in 2014 (acknowledged as high quality guidelines in the National Clearinghouse website), currently under revision and the EAACI Guidelines for Clinical Allergen Immunotherapy _ AIT Guidelines which involved 100 members from Europe and internationally . The AIT Guidelines recommendations have been published in Allergy in 2017 and collated in two EAACI books on Guidelines for Allergen Immunotherapy . She chaired the EAACI Guidelines Committee , the Task Force on Clinical trials in Children , the EAACI Health Economics Task force and is participating in the EAACI Guidelines on Atopic dermatitis .

Prof. Muraro's research is focused in identifying pathways for a personalized approach to diagnosis and treatment for allergic diseases


investigating markers for the early diagnosis allergy in children, identification of phenotypes of food allergy and anaphylaxis as well as immunotherapy for allergic diseases . She is very active in exploring new treatments for immunotherapy of food allergy . In addition she has developed educational intervention for managing anaphylaxis at the community level.

She led a project of a registry for acute allergic reaction as regional real – time based surveillance for Anaphylaxis of patients recovered in Emergency Rooms in Hospitals of the North-Eastern Veneto Region of Italy.

She promoted educational intervention for food allergy at school in the North-Eastern part of Italy (5 million inhabitants) as well as a survey on the quality of life of children with food allergies in collaboration with Food Allergy Italia the national patient's association. Dr. Muraro is actually also a powerful advocate for patients with food allergies. She works in close collaboration with Patient's Organizations and is on the medical advisory board of Food Allergy Italia. She was founder of the EAACI Patient's Organizations Committee.

Last November 2020 she was acknowledged the Clarivate Webscience Award as one of the most cited and influential scientists in the area. She is author of numerous publications in national and International Journals in the field of allergic diseases mainly food allergy ,precision medicine , immunotherapy for allergic diseases and allergy in children .
