Dario Papale is Associate Professor of Forest Ecology at the University of Tuscia (Viterbo, Italy) where he also got his PhD in 2003. His main interests are in greenhouse gases exchange and effect of climate change on terrestrial ecosystems and the use of machine learning techniques to integrate remote sensing, field measurements and models to study the interaction between abiotic and biotic components of the ecosystems.

Director of the Ecosystem Thematic Centre of the Integrated Carbon Observation System (ICOS) European Research Infrastructure since 2013, he is one of the leaders of the FLUXNET global network of GHGs exchange measurement stations. He is also member of the AmeriFlux Management Project team and he has been visiting scientist at the University of California Berkeley and at the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory.

Involved in several international projects he supervised 10 PhD students in the last 5 years. HE published more than 130 papers in international journals and is listed in the Highly Cited Researcher list in 2018, 2019 and 2020.
